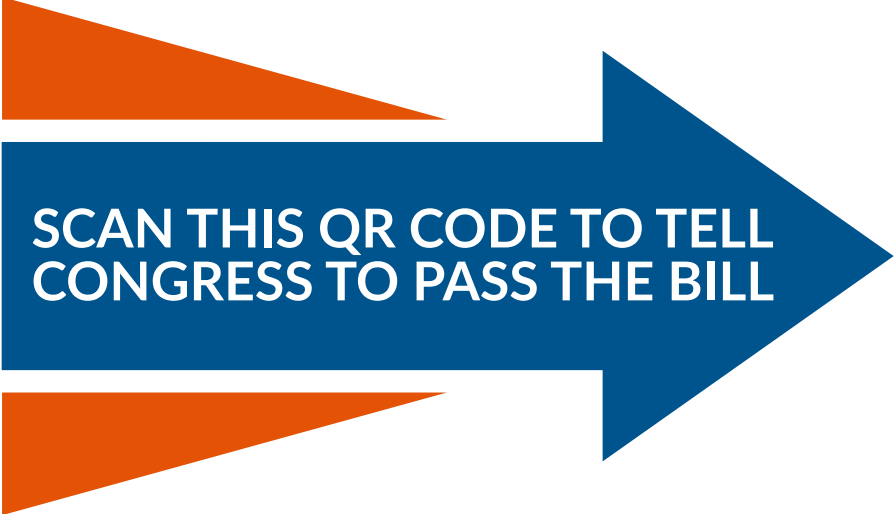




URGE CONGRESS TO PASS THE DIABETES FOOT HEALTH ACCESS AND MODERNIZATION ACT

Congress must pass H.R 7905/S. 4070, the Diabetes Foot Health Access and Modernization Act, to streamline Medicare patient access to therapeutic shoes and replace burdensome manual paperwork mandates with a simple attestation framework. The bill would also recognize podiatrists as covered physicians under the Federal Medicaid Program, establishing parity between their physician designation in Medicare. This would strengthen Medicaid patient access to care provided by podiatrists.

Through the American Podiatric Medical Association (APMA), podiatrists nationwide are advocating for their congressional representatives to support the bill. Podiatrists' voices matter to Congress, and so do the voices of their patients like you. Together, we can advance and pass reforms to prevent severe medical complications like amputations, improve patient foot health outcomes, and save patients money and time.
