### RUNNING TOWARD CHAOS

**Natalie Stavas, MD**, is a physician at Boston Children's Hospital with a special focus on preventing childhood violence.

On April 15, 2013, Dr. Stavas approached the finish line of her fifth Boston Marathon when she heard explosions. Arriving at the scene of the bombings, she administered CPR, applied tourniquets, and triaged the wounded. Subsequently, Dr. Stavas increased her efforts in preventing childhood violence. Traveling to Haiti throughout the year, she provides medical care and helps strengthen the medical infrastructure.
